Associate New Graduate

Designation: Assoc. AIA

For new grads starting their careers or working toward licensure. Free for up to 18 months.*

Associate

Designation: Assoc. AIA

For individuals who have a professional degree in architecture, work under the supervision of an architect, are enrolled in AXP, or are an architecture faculty member.

Architect

Designation: AIA

For licensed architects whether they’re newly licensed or in a leadership position.

International Associate

Designation: Int'l. Assoc. AIA

For architects licensed outside the US.
